



RULES OF PROCEDURE

1- Admission conditions

To be admitted to enter, to settle on a campsite, you must have been authorized by the person in charge of the reception office (or by the manager). The fact of staying on the site of Camping du Jard implies acceptance of the provisions of these internal regulations and the commitment to comply with them.

2- Police formalities

Anyone who has to stay at least one night in the camp must first present their identity papers to the head of the reception office and complete the formalities required by the police.

3- Installation

The tent or caravan and all equipment must be set up at the location indicated by the manager. Anyone with a reservation contract, having their caravan or tent installed by a third party must notify the campsite manager.

4- Reception desk

Open from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in low season.

At the reception desk you will find all the information on campsite services, sports facilities, tourist attractions in the surrounding area and various addresses that may prove useful.

5- Royalties

Royalties are paid at the reception desk. Their amount is set according to the rate opposite. They are due according to the number of nights spent in the field (Arrival after 4 p.m. - Departure between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m.). All users are required to notify the reception desk of their departure the day before.

6- Noise and silence

Camp users are urged to avoid all noises and discussions that may disturb their neighbors.

Sound devices must be adjusted accordingly, door and door closings must be as discreet as possible. There must be total silence between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

7- Visitors

Any additional Visitor or camper must report to reception upon arrival, and may only be admitted with the agreement of the manager of the reception desk and under the responsibility of the campers who receive them. Vehicles must remain in the entrance car park. A fee will be charged to each visitor. Current prices: € 2.00 for a daily visit, € 6.00 with pool access. Visitors must have left the campsite by 10 p.m. **Animals are not allowed**

8- Vehicle circulation and parking

Inside the campsite vehicles must be driven at a limited speed or not. All traffic is prohibited between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. (cars, motorcycles, bicycles, etc.). Only vehicles belonging to campers staying there can circulate in the camp. Parking, which is strictly prohibited on pitches usually occupied by camping shelters, must not, moreover, hamper traffic or prevent the installation of new arrivals.

10 Dress and aspects of the installations

Everyone is required to refrain from any action which could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the camp. It is forbidden to throw polluted water on the ground or in the gutters. The "caravanners" must obligatorily dispose of their waste water in the facilities provided for this purpose. Household waste, waste of all kinds, papers must be placed in the trash cans. Washing is strictly prohibited. Plantations and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden for the camper to hammer nails into trees, to cut branches, to plant. It is also not allowed to demarcate the site of an installation by personal means or to dig the ground. Any degradation committed to the vegetation, the ground, or the installations will be the responsibility of its author. For all travel, please use the routes provided for this purpose.

11- Security

A) FIRE. Open fires and electric barbecues are strictly prohibited. Stoves must be kept in good working order.

Fire extinguishers are available to everyone. In case of fire, notify management immediately. A first aid kit is available at the reception desk.

B) THEFT: Management is only responsible for items left at the office. Immediately report to the manager the presence in the camp of any suspicious person. Although security is provided, users of the campsite are invited to take the usual precautions to safeguard their equipment.

12 Games

No violent or annoying games can be organized near the facilities. The meeting room cannot be used for hectic games.

13- Camp leader

He is responsible for the order and the good running of the camp. It has a duty to sanction serious movements in the settlement and if necessary to expel their perpetrators.
