

INTERNAL REGULATIONS

In the interests of all our customers, please note the following points:

1) ADMISSION AND RESIDENCE CONDITIONS

Anyone wishing to enter or stay on the campsite must first report to reception. Staying on the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these rules and a commitment to comply with them. All contracting parties must be at least 18 years of age. Minors must be accompanied by their parents or legal guardians throughout their stay.

2) WEARING THE BRACELET

All guests staying at the campsite must wear a non-transferable wristband as soon as the campsite opens.

3) INSTALLATION

Campsites: the outdoor facility and related equipment must be installed on the specified site in accordance with the instructions given by the manager or his representative. Rented accommodation: Customers will stay on the pitch indicated in accordance with the instructions given by the manager or his representative. No additional installations (e.g. tents) are permitted on rental pitches. It is everyone's responsibility to ensure that their pitch looks good and is clean. The pitch must be left clean on the day of your departure. If the accommodation or pitch has not been cleaned before your departure, a cleaning fee will be charged.

4) MAINTENANCE AND APPEARANCE OF FACILITIES

Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could damage the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite and its facilities, particularly sanitary facilities. It is forbidden to dispose of waste water on the ground or in the gutters. Facilities are provided for this purpose. Household waste, rubbish of any kind and paper must be deposited in the various selective sorting containers available at the campsite exit. Planting and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden to put nails or sardines in trees, to cut branches or to plant anything. It is forbidden to demarcate the site of an installation by personal means, or to dig up the ground. Any damage to vegetation, fences, grounds or campsite facilities will be charged to the person responsible.

5) NOISE AND SILENCE

Each tenant is responsible for any disturbance or nuisance caused by people staying with him or visiting him. Guests are asked to avoid any noise or discussion that might disturb their neighbours. Sound equipment must be adjusted accordingly, and doors and gates must be closed as quietly as possible. There must be complete silence between 11pm and 7am.

6) TRAFFIC ON THE CAMPSITE

Only vehicles belonging to campers staying at the campsite are authorised to circulate on the campsite. Traffic inside the campsite is limited to 10 km/h. The entrance gates are closed at 11pm and no cars or motorbikes are allowed on the campsite from 11pm to 7am. Vehicles must be parked in the car park at the entrance to the campsite.

7) ANIMALS

Animals are not permitted on the campsite.

8) VISITORS

Any holidaymaker receiving visitors during the day must inform reception. Visitors' cars are not allowed on the campsite. Visitors are not permitted to use the swimming pool.

9) AQUATIC AREA

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by their parents or legal guardians to gain access to the pool. Please observe the health and safety instructions posted at the pool entrance. Deckchairs and sun loungers are not subject to reservation. Swimming shorts are permitted.

10) GAMES

No violent or disturbing games may be organised. Children must always be supervised by their parents.

11) SAFETY

a) Fire Open fires (wood, coal, etc.) and electric appliances (barbecues and plancha grills) are strictly prohibited. Stoves must be kept in good working order and not used in dangerous conditions. Fire extinguishers are available to everyone. In the event of fire, notify the management immediately before proceeding to the assembly point located in the car park at the entrance to the campsite.

b) Theft All campers' personal belongings (bicycles, etc.) remain their responsibility throughout their stay. The campsite declines all responsibility in the event of an incident for which the camper is liable. Although security is provided during the high season, campsite users are advised to take the usual precautions to safeguard their equipment.

12) DEPARTURE ARRANGEMENTS AND TOURIST TAX

Guests are asked to inform the reception desk of their departure the day before. Tourist taxes are paid at the reception desk. They are payable according to the number of nights spent on site. The amount varies from one commune to another (€0.66 per night and per person aged 18 and over). Any undeclared supplements (extra person, etc.) discovered during an inspection during the stay will be billed to the customer from the date of arrival.

13) INFRINGEMENT OF THE INTERNAL RULES

In the event of a holidaymaker disrupting the stay of other users or failing to comply with the provisions of these rules and regulations, the manager or his representative may, verbally or in writing, if he deems it necessary, give formal notice to the holidaymaker to cease the disturbance. In the event of serious or repeated breaches of the internal rules and regulations, and after the manager has served formal notice to comply, the contract may be terminated. In the event of a criminal offence, the manager may call in the police.
